Notes to the full year accounts - Income

Donations are mainly from second hand kit sales.

Pool comparison with previous year – Salendine Nook pool would no longer take our booking so only 1 block of pool sessions available for booking at new pool.

Activities income from SUP and other courses where participants had to pay for certificates/place on safety courses

Training income in the last financial year was all grant funded (British Canoeing/Paddle UK Bursary) so shows in separate line (unlike previous year where it was shown in coaching/Training)

Other - when we swopped utility provider we received a refund and this year had club clothing orders. Don't forget our FREE income from Easy Funding raising – for online purchases – please use if you can.

Notes to the full year accounts - Expenditure

Bills - Management fees increased but water and electric costs were down so Bills costs less Buildings and site - costs down this year but we still have to sort Showers in changing rooms so also refrained from purchasing new equipment.

Training – club covers part of the cost for coach training which is partly offset by grants.

Grants – Some of the expenditure for grants was last financial year and was shown in Training column

Fee charges from online payments

At the February 2021 AGM members agreed to no longer off Paypal as a payment option because of the fees involved and where possible to encourage members to use bank transfer rather than go cardless for the same reason. However we have kept the Go Cardless option for members who prefer that option.

Finance issues into 2024/25

The Club has started to run white water slalom competitions at the shallower water Sheffield Canoe Club site and required purchase of a card reading machine to take on the day entry fees. This was a one-off payment for the machine but does mean we can use it for membership etc. However there is also a cost to every use as GoCardless so we would prefer to have bank transfers.

The Slalom event brings in money for club funds from entry fees and catering, but needs volunteers to help out on one or both days or even a couple of hours setting up or taking down the course. Not a problem if you are new to slalom – we can teach you what you need to know whether its safety role, start or finish, helping with catering, clerking for results or even learning how to judge. It also gives members an opportunity to take part in a relatively easy slalom event for run, skill development or competition. It's a family event with basic camping facilities available next to the river. Our 2025 event is on 5th and 6th of July. Please come and join us
